Crazy 8s win for John Fisher

BELLFLOWER, Calif. – Anaheim's John Fisher took both the qualifying round and the final round of Crazy Eights at Oskar's Sports Bar & Grill to win the fourth event of the bar's second annual Crazy Eight series in Bellflower. Fisher scored an amazing 62 points in the finals, by far the most points scored since the series began last year, to finish 12 points ahead of series leader Karl Spickelmier to earn the win that was worth \$172.

Fame form carries Waters, Mako to win

VANCOUVER, British Columbia — Living up to their Pacific Northwest Hall of Fame status, Frank Mako and Mike Waters won the Open Doubles during the Canadian Open Table Shuffleboard tournament Aug. 12-15 at Legion #48.

Mako from Port Orchard and Waters, from Tahuya, went undefeated in the round robin tournament defeating all five of their opponents. Gordie Smith-Eric Kolsrud, both from Vancouver finished second.

The Division II doubles ended in championship fashion when Vera Brown lagged a four as she and Bill Walker captured the title. They're both from Port Orchard. Marty Atkinson-Susan Clark, Vancouver, claimed second place while Dick Moore-Bert Darvault, Vancouver, placed fourth.

Tournament supporters added \$400 to the entry fee money in the Division I and II doubles from the sale of raffle tickets.

Fisher and Spickelmier along with ten other local and Orange County players gathered at the Bellflower bar and grill on Saturday afternoon, August 21, for the fourth event in the six scheduled tournaments. Each player shot six rounds on OsKar's three fast boards to begin the qualifying session. After the dust had settled it was Cerritos' Joe Muniz and Bellflower's Craig Amundson joining Fisher and Spickelmier for the finals of the event. Fisher scored 47 points in the qualifying session to lead the four qualifiers into the finals.

In the finals it was all Fisher as he scored 21, 18 and 23 points with Spickelmier, Amundson and Muniz rounding out the final three places. Fisher played flawlessly recording no hicks in the finals.

In the tournament series Spickelmier retained the lead in points with 42 having won the first two rounds. Muniz moved into second place with 30 points followed by Yorba Linda's Bob Brunskill with 29, Huntington Beach's Richard "Bubba" Warren with 28 and Fisher and Whittier's Tim O'Brien tied with 27. Amundson and Long Beach's Gary Jones follow with 26 and 25 points respectively. Warren won the third round of the tournament series in June. Players earn series points for participation and final tournament placement. After four rounds there is now \$290 in the season point fund. A total of 23 players have participated in the tournament series.

Paramount's Paul Weber serves as the series director. Owner Oscar Ugarte contributes \$200 to the championship fund at the end of the series in December. The next Crazy Eights tournament is scheduled for Saturday, October 9, at Oskar's Sports Bar & Grill. League race wide open as first half comes to close

BELLFLOWER, Calif. – Each Wednesday night a group of 28 shuffleboard players and many of their friends gather for a night of fun and high expectations at Oskar's Sports Bar & Grill in Bellflower, Ca. To a stranger walking into Oskar's for the first time on a league night, it becomes readily apparent that the folks who bang and lag the blue and red weights on the long tables are having fun. Loud screams of excitement and many rounds of applause for great shots are the way for the evening at Oskar's. For the players it's a chance to get together with friends, to leave work and worries behind and to relax and enjoy the competition and sportsmanship involved in belonging to the Southern California Shuffleboard League.

And this particular season it is more competitive than ever. Four teams are within one game of each other as the first half of the league wound to a close last Wednesday, August 18.

Tied at the top are the Fire Femmes led by their Captain Chris Brown from and Egyptian Vikings led by the irrepressible and flamboyant Mina Bischara. Both teams have won 14 of their first 24 games. Dave Brennan's Silver Hammers and Joe Muniz's Hooters team follow the two leaders, both one game back with 13 wins apiece. It is the closest league race in recent years.

The seven team league, which traces its history back some 30 years, plays a 48 game summer schedule that began on July 7 and ends October 20. The league takes two weeks off during the season – one for the Billy Chiles Memorial Tournament at the Huntington Beach Moose Lodge over the Labor Day weekend and the other for

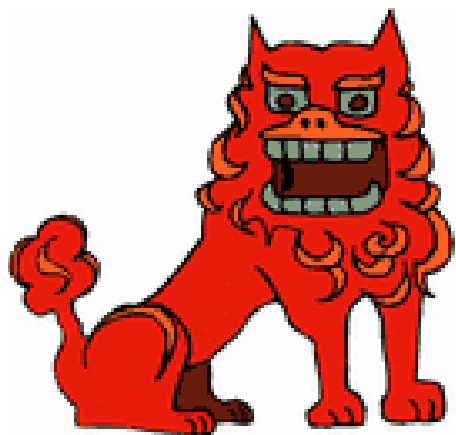
