

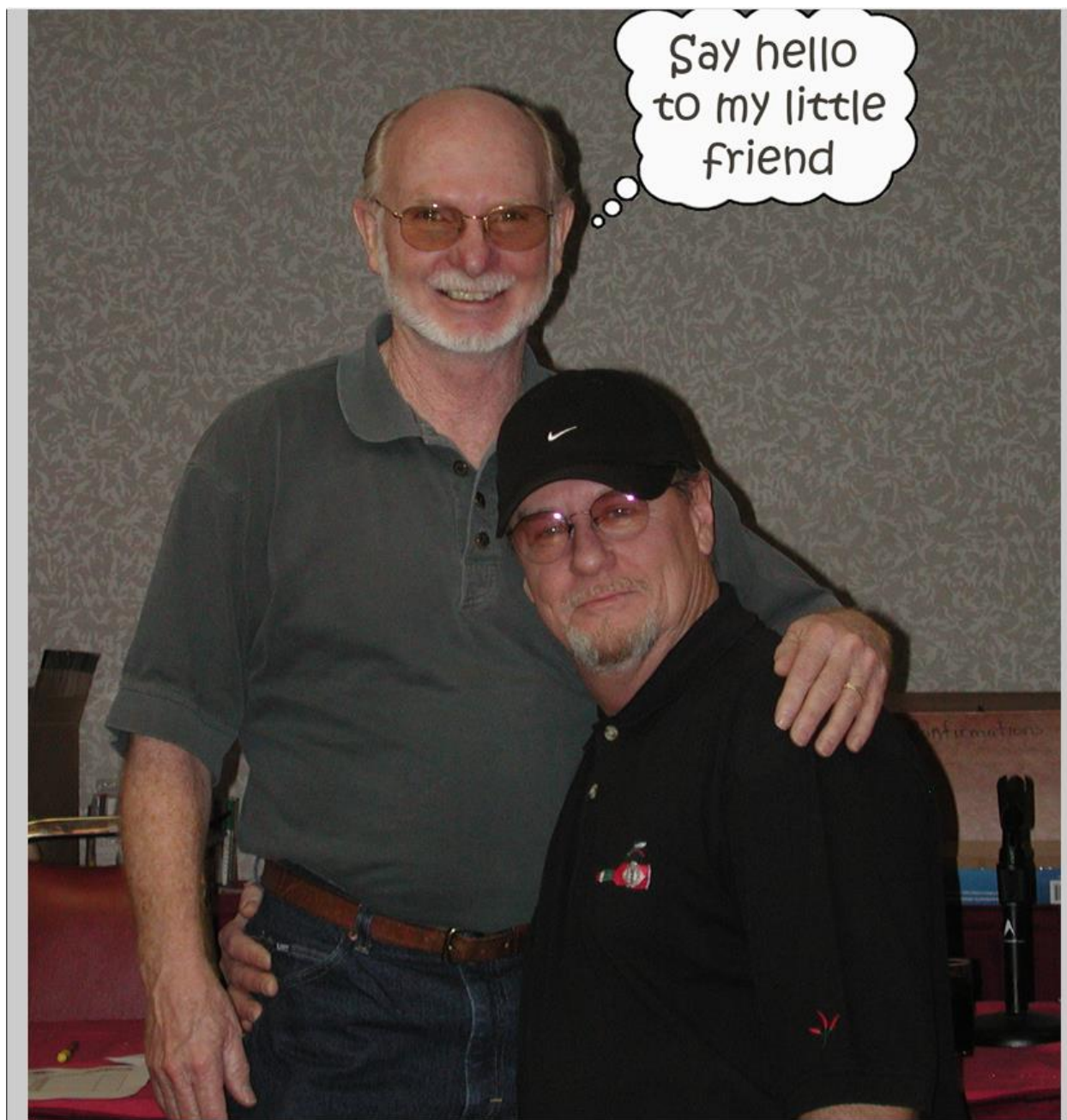
20th Annual NASC™
