Records fall in Michigan Open

Wilburs honored for efforts

Another successful turnout occurred at Kane's Club Car during this year's Michigan Open Tournament in honor of George and Donna Wilbur. A total of 103 shuffleboard patrons participated in this four day tournament, including the following events: Mixed Doubles on Friday, Three Person Bring Open and Three Person Bring Division II on Saturday, Open Singles and Division II Singles on Sunday, and Open Doubles and Division II Doubles on Monday. Just under \$42,000 was up for grabs, as a NEW RECORD was set for the Michigan Open Tournament!

On Friday, 27 teams participated in the Mixed Doubles event. First place victory went to Alonzo Cottrell and Sandy Blade (sponsored

by Bill Kane). Second place winners were Darol Nelson and Cassie Schubert (sponsored by Jerry Siebert), third place recipients were Mike Johnson and Jody Berry (sponsored by Jerry

Siebert), and fourth place went to Steve Auten and Carrie Siple (sponsored by Bobby Voorhis). Finishing in fifth and sixth were John McDermott with Linda Mitchell (sponsored by them-

selves), and Larry Brown with Mary Brown (sponsored by Dennis Bittner).

On Saturday, a combined total of 54 players battled in the two Three Person Bring events. First place in the Open

Rural American Championship

WINSTON, Ore. — The Rural American Championship at Steve Fisher's 99 Tavern and Willee's Sports Bar usually attracts one of the largest fields in the Pacific Northwest for the five-day event. The tournament opens on Thursday, Sept. 2 and will conclude on Monday, Sept. 6 if necessary.

This year Fisher has made some changes in the format for the 2004 tournament in this southwestern Oregon town.

One of the changes is the addition of a C singles tournament.

"I've had requests and the idea sounds good to me," Fisher said recently.

Fisher said the division point between B and C players hasn't been determined but expects it will be around 2.5, using the Bower's Rating system. The C singles will be single game, double elimination.

Players rated 1 to will again be able to enter the Open singles on a graduated entry fee scale.

"Allowing 1s to enter into the Open singles at a graduated entry turned out to be a booster for the event," Fisher said. The entry fee for -1s and 0s is \$200 with 1s, and higher, paying \$100. The Open Singles is 2 out of 3 in the winners' and losers' brackets.

The Open singles, which often draws the best West Coast players, starts at noon

Some 1s could be faced with a decision because players above .51 can enter the B singles where the entry fee is \$25 per player. The B singles is single game, double elimination.

The tournament opens at 6 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 2 with an A-B draw that has a \$20 entry fee.

In addition to the Open Singles on Friday, Sept. 3, there'll be an open draw at 3 p.m. It has a \$20 entry fee.

The B singles begins at 9 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 4 and the C singles gets underway at 10 a.m.

The Open doubles begins at 9 a.m. on Sunday, Sept. 5. The entry fee is \$150 per team. The format is two-out-of three in the winners' and losers' brackets.

The B doubles is also scheduled to start at 9 a.m. Sunday. Teams must add to 4 to be eligible and the entry fee is \$50 per team. This event is best of three in the winners' bracket with a single game in the losers' bracket.

Fisher says the Labor Day weekend event has averaged more than 73 players a year.

There's RV parking available for the first 8 to 10 rigs that arrive, but there is other RV parking in the area.

There are also a number of motels in the area and Steve's listed them on the flier that's on Page 5 of this week's Lagging4s.

The tournament will be played on eight boards in the two loca
