This year, the 3rd Annual Indiana Hall of Fame "Classic" tournament honored Jim DeWitt with an induction into the IHOF. Jim started playing shuffleboard in 1966 at the triangle in Anderson Indiana. Every night at supper an old Free Hander would beat him out of a quart of beer. One night a friend named Howard Noble told him if he bought the beer he would show him how to play. After showing Jim, he said to "practice for about 16 years and he might beat him." Two weeks later, Jim beat the Free Hander "Howard" and has never seen him since. ...

Maybe two years went by and

Jim teamed up with Dale Glosser and they played at Monty's after work. Dale taught Jim the strategy of the game, and they were hard to beat.

guit playing until the Fall of 1980 when he teamed up with ob Brown and played in the Central Indiana Shuffleboard League (CISL) for about two vears... then he teamed up with Glen (Red) Newland. Red and Jim won the finales of CISL in 1985, and got 2nd in 1986... they also won the State Doubles in 1989. Jim won the State Singles in 1992. Bob Brown and Jim finished 2nd in the only known 70 team tournament in Bourbon. Glen Ingram and Jim won Bourbon for his only win up there.

In the Spring of 1980, Jim

Jim has played a lot of shuffleboard and made a lot of friends, "it's been fun", he says. Jim thinks that the toughest competition comes out of Indiana. Glen Ingram conducted the IHOF ceremony and Jim Long and Terry Dowell joined in with testimonials. Acknowledgments also went to Sheryl Cockerill, Fritzi Broka, and Sonny Harris who worked very hard to make this tournament and ceremony a great success.


