







In addition, this year Jim Foran, a long time icon in tournament table shuffleboard in the Pacific Northwest, as well as throughout the nation, was the recipient of yet another accolade in his illustrious career when he was presented with the Washington Shuffleboard Sportsman of the Year award Saturday afternoon at the 3rd annual Larry Hudson Memorial tournament. 


