Lagging4s will publish daily at Reno tourney

Lagging4s, the ezine of table shuffleboard, will be published daily during the 2004 North American Shuffleboard Championships at the Sands/Regency Hotel-Casino in Reno.

The first daily edition will come out on Sunday morning and there'll be another edition each day through the week.

There will be results and schedules as well as features and other shuffleboard information.

Each edition will be about 4 pages and will distributed on-line as well as "on paper" at the tournament.

The Reno tournament marks the second daily publishing effort for Lagging4s. In August, Lagging4s was published daily during the Whistling Oyster Grand Master's tournament in Quilcene, Wash.

RENO — If you're a table shuffleboard player who dares to dream, the pot of gold is hidden someplace at the Sands/Regency Hotel & Casino, home of the 2004 North American Shuffleboard Championships.

The nine-day tournament, which opens Saturday, features something for players at every skill level.

There are four divisions in singles and doubles; two divisions in draw partners and 4-person teams plus the every popular Pro/Am Draft Team event that opens the tournament on Saturday.

New boards, built and stored in Reno year round, and being three years removed from the 2001 terrorist attacks that kept many people out of airplanes, have increased the number of players heading for Reno for all or part of the tournament.

Finding the Reno ‘Groove’

RENO — If he'd wanted to, he could have counted the individual grains of powder as they bounced into the air while the shuffleboard was being prepared for the next game.

Deep inside he was calm even though he was about to play for the Singles title in the North American Shuffleboard Championship at the Sands/Regency Hotel.

He knew this feeling, even though it was somewhat rare for him.

“Grooved” is how he described the sensation when concentration and confidence walked on the same path through his mind.

“Savor the moments” he reminded himself as he waited for the match to begin. Winning was assured, only the final scores weren't known.

He'd called his wife shortly after moving into the championship match with a victory in the winners' bracket final and even thought about inviting her to fly out to Reno to be with him for the monumental win he knew was coming.

But, he didn't ask her.

Not for financial reasons. They both had good-paying jobs, some money in the bank and the envelope he'd collect at the end of the tournament was going to be worth five figures.

She most likely would have flown out if he'd asked and never complained for a second, but he knew it would upset the routine that she wrapped herself in like a big, comfortable blanket.

Married for nearly 30 years, they were somewhat of an odd-couple.

While she was most comfortable in routine, he was impetuous and liked doing things on a moment's notice. He was spontaneous and impulsive.

The difference in their styles didn't often get in the way of their marriage.

Probably because she realized long before they were married that there would always be a little wanderlust in this man and being confident about his feelings for her made it easy for her to wave good-bye, knowing he'd be back soon.

his cheek where a sucker punch caught him in a bar fight. He also had a better understanding of himself, the game and life.

He was only home a couple of days before he looked her up.

“Missed you,” he said.

“There must have been some girls out there on the road,” she pushed.

“Didn’t think about that,” he answered matter of factly.

He drank a little bit more when he got back and she worried that it might be a problem, but a couple of months later he was drinking less than before he left.

She went to college and he found a career job that didn’t require a four-year education and they married a couple of years later.

Shuffleboard was still important in his life and she enjoyed watching him play. She learned how to play and every once in a while she would beat him to death on the board they put in the garage.

He went to about a tournament a month and he socked away whatever he won in order to pay for the next one.

Not that the impulsiveness went out of him. There was the new car that she didn’t know about until it showed up in the driveway. Or unplanned gifts for their two girls and her.

Or the shuffleboard weights.

He had a set of “old” Americans, the high-topped Triple Crowns, brightly colored SunGlos and every series that the Shuffleboard Federation had made to date.

“What are you going to do with all of those weights?” she’d ask him when a new set was delivered.

“Never know. Might slip one in my pocket in case I need an extra hammer sometime,” he said, deadpan.

Some of the weights sat unopened in their shipping boxes on a shelf above the shuffleboard table. He had a black, plastic pistol case that held two sets of weights and that’s all he took with him

when he went to play. The other weights were held in abeyance. “Just in case.”

She never worried about him going to a tournament without her because when she did go there were never any behind the hand whispers or odd looks that would have her feel like she didn’t belong.

Sometimes, when a tournament was coming up, she’d feel him leave their bed early in the morning and she knew he was in the garage “throwing a few weights” as he called it.

When he came home from a tournament, he never volunteered to tell her how he’d done.

When he won, he’d say “got pretty lucky.” If he didn’t, there was always a good word about the opponent. And even though he laughed at the adage that the only reason to have partner was to have someone to blame when you lost, his partners didn’t get bashed even if they played terribly.

She went to Reno with him a few times and felt that special pride of watching him play well and make a little money. But, she would just as soon stay home, catch-up on some reading she’d been putting off or getting the house sparkly clean. She never told him that, but she sensed he knew that being alone for a while wasn’t bad for either one of them.

So now as his thoughts were interrupted, he wasn’t sad that he hadn’t asked her to join him.

“Hey, oldtimer,” the voice invaded his thoughts. “You ready to play?”

“Sure, flip for the hammer and we’ll get going,” he answered.

Singles events will start on Monday, the draw partners goes on Wednesday, with 4 person teams on Thursday and doubles starting on Friday.

In addition to shuffleboard, there’s a huge party being planned by Sands/Regency officials to celebrate the tournament’s 15th anniversary.

The party starts at 7 p.m. Friday, Nov. 5 and one of the highlights will be tournament director John McDermott’s induction into the National Shuffleboard Hall of Fame. The coveted Sol Lipkin Award for contributions to the game will also be awarded during the party.

In addition, 50 people will receive \$200 awards from the \$10,000 money being added to the tournament by the Sands/Regency.

Also during the week, California’s Eddie Brayman will show off his “Computer Peas” program for running tournaments. No specific times have been set for those demonstrations but there will be plenty of notice.

In order to spice up some dull Navy life aboard ship, American Shuffleboard rep Sol Lipkin was called upon by the US Navy Officer and Chaplain of the Theodore Roosevelt (SSBN-600) to help get a table shuffleboard installed to give the crew something competitive to do while spending days and months on underwater missions, including an upcoming "shakedown" mission)... something more competitive than watching movies was their goal. The submarine was about to be sent from Groton, CT to Charleston, SC to be "outfitted" and the shuffleboard installation became part of the outfitting to-do list. It was installed on the torpedo rack's steel structure that lifts up/down and the legs on the shuffleboard cradle had to be drastically shortened to accommodate to be the correct height needed for play from the shuffleboard's cradle. The tournament was MC'd by the Navy Commander (who was also a surgeon/doctor by trade). Sol Lipkin has a reel tape of this tournament that he is trying to locate so that it can be reproduced and preserved on more durable media. Sol does not recall the names of the Commander and Lieutenant (Sr. Grade Officer) that ended up as partners against two other crew members in the final match of the tournament, but does vividly recall the final shots of the tournament. The score was 20-20 (21 point game format) and the Captain had the last weight (hammer). His opponent threw a short weight, so it seemed almost definitely that the Captain would have no problem outpassing his opponent's short weight to capture the one point needed to win the tournament. However, it appears that someone tipped off the helmsman and with perfect timing, as the Captain threw his hammer to pass the short weight, the submarine took a tilt that placed the Captain's hammer into the "rough" (which was the Navy crew's term for when a weight went into the gutter)... so the two opposing crew members won without the hammer and with only a short weight on the board and were officially the tournament Champions!
