

at home feels.



I still face some health issues, but there's nothing that should prevent me from publishing the magazine weekly in the future.

Your words and thoughts are greatly appreciated.

Something that's been constantly reinforced since the magazine started is how much shuffleboard players care about the game and how many ideas they have to make it better. Many are willing to share their ideas — not always for publication — and I've been

lucky enough to see some pretty interesting thoughts.

In fact, I've seen enough thoughtful ideas to make me believe there needs to be a international table shuffleboard meeting to discuss the future of the sport in the very near future.

Good question. The attendees could create committees to look at ideas the group feels should be investigated more thoroughly with deadlines for making a report to table shuffleboard players.

When you walk in to the club, bar or lodge in the morning all set to play – have you ever noticed that the boards have been buffed

and sprayed? The old wax is gone from the boards and the jars are all filled with new wax? The floors have been swept or vacuumed and all that wax we threw around yesterday is gone? Chances are that was done somewhere between 2 and 7 a.m. while you were in bed sleeping.

Tournament Directors – those wonderful people who get the praise or blame if a tournament goes well or not. I do not know of one person who has directed a tournament who has not secretly said to him or herself "This is the last time I do this!" If they haven't, I want to nominate them for sainthood! It is not their fault if your partner got drunk, or your rating made you the 'A' in the ABC, or that the tournament is running behind because one match took an overly long time. If everyone at a tournament volunteered five minutes each – just think how delightful that would be!

Whether you can find some way to help out or not – there is always one thing each of us who attend a tournament should do. Smile and say "Thank You" to the people who volunteer their time! Without them, there wouldn't be any tournaments!
