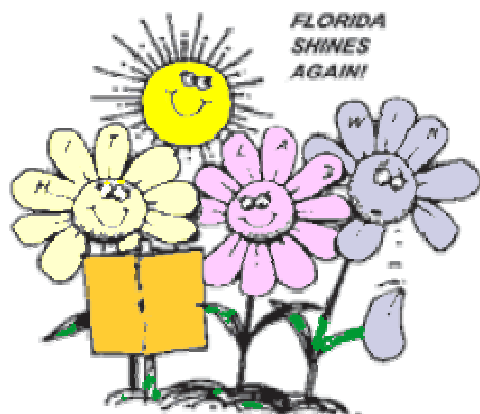

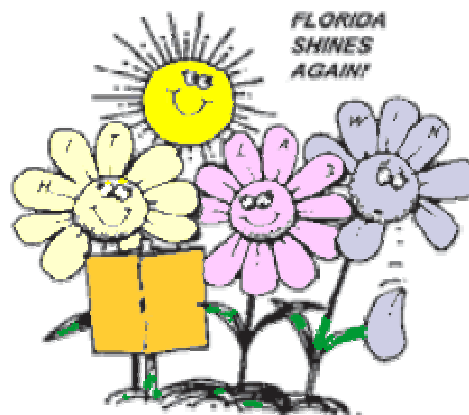

March 25th, 2006 marked the continued success at the Madison Park Bowl in Madison Heights, Michigan. Rob Kern's 2nd MDA "Send a Kid to Camp" tournament (sponsored by PLNG – Pioneers & Legends and New Generations) exceeded last year's total as well as expected goals for this year. Every year, MDA has a "send a kid to camp" program. The cost for sending one kid to camp is \$600. Last year's goal to raise enough to send one kid was exceeded by raising \$1,570. This year's goal was to raise enough to send three kids, or \$1,800. Again, our goal was exceeded by raising \$2,100. Legion Son's sponsored 2 teams.

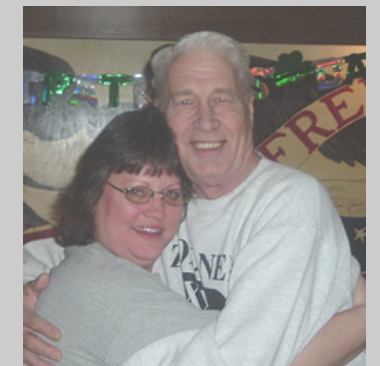
