QUILCENE, Wa. — When Gary George banged two opponents' weights off the board during the championship match of the 15th Annual Whistling Oyster Grand Masters doubles tournament on Sunday, his wife, Judy had a good feeling.

"I think he might be in a zone," Judy George said after her husband's double.

Minutes later, leading 11-9, George let the hammer slide out of his hand, then watched as it went to the left rail before it started to hook back toward the

center of the board.

The blue-topped weight had good pace as it slid through the two zone and into three.

Would it stop?

Slowing in the last three inches of the board, the weight went deep into the three zone and then a little piece of the burnished finish broke the invisible plane marking the end of the wood and the start of space as it halted for the tournament winning four.

QUILCENE, Wa. — Sliced, diced, and roasted for being the ham that he is, Donald E. "Mitch" Mitchell, winner of more than 60 tournaments and major table shuffleboard events, was inducted to the Evergreen Shuffleboard Ass'n./Pacific Northwest Shuffleboard Hall of Fame Saturday, July 31.

The honor came during the 15th Annual Grand Masters Tournament at the Whistling Oyster as Hall of Fame members Darrol Nelson, Frank Mako, Tommy Campbell, Mike Waters, Clark and Clara Kenney looked on.

"This is the most important thing that's happened in my (shuffleboard) life," Mitchell said as he received his commemorative plaque from Mako, PNW Hall of Fame President.

Laughter was the order of the day, though, as table shuffleboard players recalled the fun that Mitchell has brought to the game.

He is a director on the California Shuffleboard Hall of Fame board and is a rater for the Bowers Rating System in Southern California. He is the tournament director for the Memorial Day and Thanksgiving Day events held at Oskar's Sports Bar & Grill in Bellflower, Calif. He also handles all sponsor sales for tournaments in Southern and Central California. He lives in Paramount, Calif. and is married to wife Hope.

Shuffleboard Etiquette Or just plain good sportsmanship and respect

Have any of you been to a tournament or even just a large round robin where you've felt uncomfortable because of the behavior of a handful of others? One or two jerks can spoil the day for an entire room full of players and spectators. And we've been letting them get away with this!

You go to watch the finals of a tournament and some loud mouth, which was on one of the first teams eliminated, decides to yell out remarks and/or shouts at the players who knocked him out of the tournament. Loud remarks or comments come over and over again. The players are getting frustrated. You're getting frustrated. Pretty soon one of the players is bound to turn and start yelling back. And all this could have been avoided.

In this instance, the tournament director should have let "loudmouth" know his behavior would not be tolerated. If the behavior continued after that, "loudmouth" should have been "86'd" from the bar/hall. If this is typical behavior for "loudmouth" and happens often, don't let him play in any tournaments in this establishment again!

You as a player or spectator, also have a voice. If enough people had told "loudmouth" he was behaving badly, he might have quieted down earlier. That doesn't mean you should walk up and tell him to "Shut the #%\$@ up!" Just remind him that the players in the finals played hard to get there, and would he please show some respect and good sportsmanship and quiet down. If it continues after that, complain to the tournament director. I've actually had tournament directors tell me they didn't do anything about old "loudmouth" because no one said anything to him about the matter!

I was the tournament director at a recent tournament and made a speech just before the sponsor sale. In it I stated that this tournament would be run on the rules of "Good Sportsmanship and Respect." I outlined the behavior I expected from both the players and the spectators. And I made it known that bad behavior would not be tolerated. I made a similar speech the next night before the sponsor sale of the second event. There were one or two times during the event when I had to merely walk over to a spectator and quietly ask them to settle down. They immediately did, even though in both cases the spectator had a few too many drinks.

In brief here are a few guidelines for attending a tournament.

If you are a player:

• Have respect for your partner (i.e. be prompt. Don't get drunk or high.)

• Have respect for your opponents.

• Don't wander off between matches or just sit drinking. Volunteer to help! Pick up empty glasses and wash them for the bartender. Take out trash. Give someone who needs it a backrub! Keep mentally and physically active and your game won't be hurt by the wait.

• Once you've been knocked out show some good sportsmanship. If you want to drown your sorrows do it quietly.

If you're a sponsor:

• Why on earth would you buy a team and then start buying See Page 13

them drinks? Are you crazy?

• No one needs to be reminded that you own them. I have never seen a team play better because their sponsor goaded them into it.

• Once you buy a team leave them alone to play their game.

If you are a spectator:

• It is great to applaud good shots or compliment a player for a good shot. But please, do not offer advice on what shot to make! Or yell at or to the players. You are actually breaking their concentration and annoying others around you.

• If you must go outside or to the restroom and the only path is behind where the players are shooting, wait until they are done at that end of the board. If possible use another exit or route.

• If you absolutely must become drunk and annoying go somewhere else!

If you are a tournament director, bar owner or bar staff:

•It is up to you to have a successful tournament. Establish rules and stick to them. If you tell players that they will be put on the clock if they are late – do it! If you say drunk and rowdy people will be asked to leave – follow through. You do not have to be a tyrant. Just establish some common sense rules that establish good sportsmanship and respect for others and let the rules be known.

• I guarantee that if people enjoy a tournament they will be back.

When it comes to shuffleboard remember that respect, good sportsmanship and common sense mean that everyone will have a good time. And isn't that why we all play this game? Okay, winning has a little something to do with it too.
