A Breakdown of all Divisions Diamond Division qualifies most players!

The Format: Each division must have at least 4 players to start a qualifying group. Once a division fills the four spots round robin elimination play begins. Each player plays 1 game against each of the other 3 players. The Top 2 go onto a single elimination match. The Top 2 is decided first by who has the most wins, if that's a tie it goes to most points scored. If both the wins and points scored are a tie it goes to least points given up. Each player also wins Instant Cash back for each win during the round robin elimination round determined by what division they are playing in. The qualifiers go onto a Single Elimination Bracket Final!

Ruby Division: Nick Smith, Derek Cozad, and Travis McGlothin all qualified leading to the finals. Derek qualified in both Ruby and Quartz and chose to play in the Quartz finals.
