Michigan HOF Tournament Events Overview

A total of \$12,610 was up for grabs as fierce competition flourished throughout the weekend.

Friday kicked off the weekend 34 players in the first AB draw and 24 players in the second AB draw. In the first AB draw, first place went to Jim Long & Melinda Flynn (sponsored by Betty Parrish), with second place going to Brenda Kane & Daniel Chapman (sponsored by Betty Parrish). Tied for third place were John Myles & Cindy Brown (sponsored by Wayne Atkinson), and Jimmy Kumpula & Slick Parrish (sponsored by Bob Auten).

In the second AB draw, first place went to Steve "CoCo" Brown & Jesse Lainhart (sponsored by themselves), and second place to Steve Auten & Melinda Flynn (sponsored by Jason Papa). 

