It was also through shuffleboard, at around the same time, that she met her future husband, Dave Loughren.

Shortly after she started playing, she met Art Evans who took her under his wing and taught her how to REALLY play the game of competitive shuffleboard. In 1986, she joined the Saskatchewan Shuffleboard Association playing out of the German Club in Regina. She remained a league member and competitor until after the 2000 Canadian Championships in Regina, at which time Cheryl & Dave both took a break from the game to concentrate on raising their two sons: Tom & Dan.

In 2010, Cheryl & Dave both returned to the game of shuffleboard and once again started a league team; this time bringing their two sons along as players.

In 2012, Cheryl and Dan won the Mixed Doubles and represented Saskatchewan at the Canadian Shuffleboard Championships.

Cheryl currently sits on the executive for the Saskatchewan Shuffleboard Association for her 2nd consecutive term and is the Chairperson for the 2014 Canadian Shuffleboard Championships.
