## Jane Mourgos

Jane grew up in the small town of York, Nebraska (her and her twin are the youngest of 7 children). She first discovered shuffleboard after moving back to Lincoln, Nebraska after attending college at the University of Nebraska – Lincoln in the late 1970's.



In Lincoln, Jane played on many softball teams and her teammates would go down to the bars (to celebrate wins) and that is when she discovered shuffleboard. She would play shuffleboard with her friends and, loving the competition, it quickly became an addiction for her. She moved to California in 1981, and around 1984 she discovered a shuffleboard in a small bar in Belmont, CA (Ausielo's Tavern) where they had more competitive shuffleboard games. This is where she met her husband, Dan.

Jane believes that the shuffleboard community has created a family, and she is proud to be part of this.

Among this "family" she admires those that help support and promote the game, most of all Jim Martin. Jim is considered the shuffleboard community historian and has spent countless hours preserving and documenting shuffleboard memories by his MANY interviews, tributes, videos, and articles.

in January, 2000 when Jane believed there was talent in women who were not willing to participant in tournaments. This first "Ladies Only" tournament was held at Old Town Saloon in Livermore, CA. With the help of Lorraine Olson, Kathy Smallshire, Vickie Hunt, and huge

support from Chris Brown in Southern California, this first tournament kicked off a history of future, highly successful traveling tournaments.

The annual tournament was named "*Women Wandering the World (WWW)*" by Jeri Williams in 2001. It has continued annually and has grown in size and

popularity throughout the years, from an initial 20 participants in 2000 to 100+ at the last 2023 tournament in Detroit. The tournament has

“wandered” around the United States for the past 25 years continuing to grow and attract more and more women. The tournament supports bonding, learning, and competitiveness.

Though Jane has been credited with creating the WWW tournament, she believes that all the women who have directed, or ever participated in a WWW tournament, are the ones responsible for its continued and ongoing success. And... as Freddie Thuman first stated in January, 2000... *“This tournament will take on a life of its own”*, and he was right!!

Over the past few decades Jane has unselfishly been involved in promoting the game of shuffleboard and encouraging people to play the game and become part of the community she treasures so much.

It is with great pride that we induct Jane Mourgos into the California Shuffleboard Hall of Fame.

Jane has one son, Matthew, and currently resides with her husband, Dan, in San Mateo, CA. They enjoy many days and evenings playing games in their “Shuffle Shed” with family and friends.


