Portable toilets and a hot/cold water shower provided for the RV Park. For motels or on-ground facilities or other information contact Joyce Gamble or Tournament Directors. Pre-Registered players may indicate they have a need for RV parking in the AML 73 park when they pre-register (see Pre-Reg form) and we will give you a call to go over the details of your request. Once RV slots with 30 amp electric & water hookups are filled, only requests for self-contained units can be taken (players may request an RV space on their pre-registration form and we will contact you upon receipt of the completed form).

EARLY REGISTRATION (Postmark by June 12th- Please help us with planning and staffing by preregistering). You may pay for all of your event registrations (which we love you for) or send a minimum of your one-time pre-registration fee \$35 and \$20 per event deposit to ensure a slot in an event(s). Entries are accepted until the event is full or posted entry deadlines. Checks are accepted on pre-registrations mailed by June 12th, but checks cannot be cashed at the registration desk during the tournament (cash is required when paying for events at the tournament).

NO LATE FEES: There are NO LATE FEES.

Pre-registration is greatly appreciated as it helps the Legion with staffing, and food & drink supplies/services. Please be sure to put on your Pre-Registration Form if you have a preference of specific beverage(s) that you would like the Legion to try to stock during the tournament.

PRE-TOURNAMENT ACTIVITIES & GENERAL INFO: The Legion and back bar with 2 boards will be open at 4:00 PM on Wednesday & Thursday, June 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> (for those who come in before the start of the tournament). The Legion closes by 2:00 a.m. daily. We will open by 11:30 a.m. on Friday, July 1st & by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday July 2nd. We will have boards available for practice and informal robins starting Wednesday & Thursday at 4 p.m. on the two boards in back bar area. The boards in the main hall should be ready for practice on Friday (July 1st) about 12 noon. The Legion has an ATM and also accepts credit cards (which must be closed out on a daily basis) for food and drinks only. There will be an open Wifi internet service inside the facility.

FIVE 2015 MVP AWARDS: Event's Overall Total Point Accumulation for 5 Rated Categories: (1) -1's; (2) 0's; (3) 1's; (4) 2's; (5) 3-5's.

ROUND-ROBIN AWARDS: We will be running official robins starting at 6pm on Friday July 1st and throughout the tournament when boards are available. At the end of the tournament there will be one MVP Robins Award. You must be a registered player to capture the MVP Robin Award. LEGION KITCHEN HOURS: 9-11 a.m. (breakfast) - 12N-9p.m. (kitchen menu) during the tournament.

NOTE: Wed. July 6th Announcements & Recognitions will start at 4:00 p.m. and final registration (if any openings) for 6-Person Draft Final ROLL CALL at 6:00 p.m (and Free BBQ 4-6 p.m.).

## **Event Information**

- Event 1 Division I A/B Draw: \$60 per player. This event is open to -1's, 0's, and 1's. Single game/Double elimination. There will be a roll call for this event and you must be present.
- Event 2 Division II A/B Draw: \$40 per player. This event is open to 2', 3's, & 4's. Single game/Double elimination. There will be a roll call for this event and you must be present.
- Event 3 Division I 4-Person Bring Team: \$300 per team, 2 of 3 / Double Elimination team handicap must add to 1 point or more. Only one -1 per team allowed. Pay at tournament.
- **Event 4 Division II 4-Person Bring Team:** \$200 per team, same as Event #3 above except team handicap must add to 9 points or more. No *-1s* or 0's allowed in this event. Pay at tournament.
- Event 5 Pro Division Singles: (-1's \$200 / -0's \$150 / +0's \$100\*). This event is open to -1's and 0's. 2 out of 3 / Double Elimination (winner & loser bracket).
- Note \*: If there are openings the day of the event, any other division players may participate in Event 5 for \$100.
- Event 6 Division I Singles: (1's \$75/2's & Up \$50) This event is open to 1's thru 4's. 2 out of 3 in the winner bracket/single game to 21 points in loser bracket.
- **Event 7 Division II Singles**: (3's \$30/4's \$20). This event is open to 3's & 4's. 2 out of 3 in the winner bracket/single game to 21 point in loser bracket.
- Event 8 6-Person Draft Team: \$50 per player. This event is open to <u>ALL</u>. The top rated registered players will be the designated captains\*. Best 5 out of 9/Double elimination, 12 point games. There will be a roll call for this event and you must be present for roll call or you cannot be included in the captain's draft list choices. \*Note: If any 1's are captains, they will get 1st draft pick.
- Event 9 Pro Division Bring Partner: \$200 per team/\$100 each. This event is open to -1's thru 4's. No two -1s can partner up. 2 out of 3/double elimination (winner & loser brackets).
- Event 10 Division I Bring Partner: \$150 per team/\$75 each. Add to 3 or more. This event is open to 1's thru 4's (add to 3 or more). 2 out of 3 in winner bracket/single game to 21 in loser bracket.
- Event 11 Division II Bring Partner: \$80 per team/\$40 each. Add to 6 or more. This event is open to 2's thru 4's (add to 6 or more). 2 out of 3 in winner bracket/single game to 21 in loser bracket.
- Note: All events are 15 point games unless otherwise stated (some are 21 point in loser bracket only)

NO QUARTERS NEEDED FOR BOARDS; A ONE-TIME BOARD USE FEE \$10/player (vs. quarters).
