Times are entry deadlines if there are any spots available. Auction will begin shortly thereafter and play ASAP.

Event #1 Sunday 12:30 pm	Bring your own 4 person team. \$200 per team, 2/3 double elimination. Team handicap must add to 1 point or more, only 1 pro per team
Event #2 Sunday 12:30 pm	Same as #1 except team handicap must add to 9 points or more. No pro's or 0s allowed \$120 per team
Event #3 Monday 3:00 pm	Open Singles - 2/3 double elimination, handicap entry fee (-1.00 \$300) (-0.51 to -0.99 \$200) (0 \$100). The possibility exists money finalist may not be able to play in event #5, in which case entry deposit will be refunded and MVP points adjusted.
Event #4 Monday 3:00 pm	Amateur Singles - Single game/double elimination, handicap entry (1s \$75) (2s \$50) (3s & 4s \$25) NO PROS OR ZEROS

Event #5 Wednesday 10:30 am	Draw Partner Division I - Single game, double elimination. No two pros can draw together \$50 entry
2 rated players have the option of playing in event #5 or #6, but not both	
Event #6 Wednesday 10:30 am	Draw Partner Division II - Single game, double elimination, 2 rated players cannot draw together \$30 entry
Event #7 Thursday 10:00 am	Draft Team - Everyone gets in this one. Pros and Os will be captains, 4/7 double elimination, mark 3 \$50 entry fee
Event #8 Saturday 9:00 am	Bring Partner Division I - Handicap total of 0 or more, single game double elimination. \$150 per team
Event #9 Saturday 9:00 am	Singles for 2 rated players, single game double elimination \$40 entry
Event #10 Saturday 9:00 am	Singles for 3 & 4 rated players, single game double elimination \$30 entry

Entry into events #3-10 earn points toward the added money. Each event entered earns 3 points. A 7th or 8th place earns 4 points. A 5th or 6th earns 5 points. A 4th place earns 6 points, 3rd place 7 points, 2nd place 8 points and 1st place 9 points. If slow play becomes a problem the tournament director reserves the right to mark 3 in the losers bracket.
