Wes Martin

Wes Martin was born in Farmersville, CA and grew up in Exeter, where he still lives.
During his first year at COS (College of the Sequoias), he was offered a part-time job at Westinghouse and ended up working there for over 18 years! Wes is married to Kathy and has 2 children, Ryan and Lauren, who are both avid shuffleboard players.



Wes was more of a pool player back when he met Leslie Goldsmith who introduced him to shuffleboard. They played at Mr. G's and he began to learn the game quickly and assist with local tournaments. Later, the action moved to the Exeter Eagles Lodge where he continued to learn, play, and grow the game locally, with his good buddy, Sal Reynoso.

Wes' first big tournament was at Blinkys (in Santa Clara) but would then go to tournaments held at the Peanut House in Southern California. In the late 1980's, he traveled to Las Vegas and participated in John McDermott's tournament at the Sahara. During this time, he continued learning the game and was influenced by other CSHOF greats such as Karl Spickelmeier, Jim McDonald, Steve Floyd, and Marion Bailey.





Over the years, Wes has teamed up and has won many doubles events at the Exeter Eagles Lodge, with partners including "Danger" (JR Noel), Marion Bailey, Sal Reynoso, Ryan Martin, and many others. One of Wes' goals is to promote and help shuffleboard grow in the Exeter area. Not only does Wes help and run local tournaments, he provides lessons for beginners to try to "hook" them so they will continue to play and enjoy the game. Wes sponsors an annual ladies' tournament ("Jodi Parks Annual Ladies Shuffleboard Tournament") which allows him to bring women together from all rating classes to experience the fun and competition of shuffleboard. At the most recent tournament, Wes was presented with the 1st "Jodi Parks Award" for his contributions to promote and support the game of shuffleboard. He was recognized for his commitment to advance women's participation in shuffleboard and for his tireless efforts to create opportunities and inspire a new generation of shuffleboard players. Wes' vision and leadership, along with his unwavering support, help build the Exeter shuffleboard community.

Wes has been a member of the Eagles Lodge for about 35 years – being an officer for about 30 of those years. Because of his long-standing Eagle's affiliation, his influence is significant and valued greatly. Wes is a California Shuffleboard Hall of Fame Director and is a member of the Exeter Eagles Shuffleboard Committee.

It is an honor for the California Shuffleboard Hall of Fame to name Wes Martin as its 41st inductee. **Congratulations**!


